They will be prepared for their clinical and extern rotations and already have the training to be hired immediately after graduation.

Programs of Study Offered

Dental Assistant

Focus of study includes: taking vital signs, performing CPR, sterilizing instruments, preparation of instrument trays, oral inspections, exposure and processing of x-rays, fluoride treatments, educating patients on proper oral care, appointment scheduling, creating patient charts, maintaining records and supplies, accounts payable and fee collections, and working with insurance forms.

Dental Hygiene

Focus of study includes: taking medical and dental histories, vital signs, extra and intra oral examinations, periodontal and dental examinations, radiographs, and risk assessments.

Medical Assistant

Focus of study includes: CPR, patient histories, taking and reading vital signs EKGs, administering injections, venipunctures (drawing blood/ phlebotomy), assisting in cast application and removal, minor surgery, instrument usage, patient preparation, basic lab procedures, diagnostic procedures, patient charting, appointment scheduling, patient billing and fee collections, insurance coding, payroll, computers, medical records, and insurance forms.

Medical Office Administration

Focus of study includes: accounts receivable and payable, billing and fee collection, payroll and taxes, records management, insurance claims processing, typing and word processing, computer applications, medical terminology, anatomy, oral and written communications, and public relations

Physical Therapist Assistant

Focus of study includes: therapeutic exercise, functional training, mobility training, ambulation training, activities of daily living, treatments using electrical stimulation, treatments using massage, treatments that use heat and cold,

treatments that use traction, balance and coordination training, and measurement assessment of range of motion and strength.

Respiratory Therapy

Focus of study includes: oxygen therapy, bronchodilator, chest physiotherapy, patient teaching and instruction, ECG, ventilator and airway management, bronchoscopy assistant, arterial blood gas analysis, pulmonary function testing, home respiratory care, trauma and CPR team, pulmonary rehabilitation, NICU monitoring, hemodynamic monitoring, chest tube theory, advanced pharmacology, ACLS protocol, and renal effects on the respiratory patient.

Vocational Nurse

Focus of study includes: anatomy and physiology, pharmacology, administration of medications, legal and ethical responsibilities, nutrition, common disease processes, preventative nursing care, therapeutic nursing care, rehabilitative nursing care, restorative nursing care, nursing interventions for patient care, cultural differences in caring for patients, phsychosocial impact of disease, and leadership principles.
